This course will prepare you for working in the aged care sector and studying the CHC 33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing & HACCs) at Yarraville Community Centre.

This course aims to develop learner's literacy and numeracy capabilities and understanding of aged care as a pathway to the Certificate III in Individual Support.

The course includes an introduction to the aged care sector with a focus on entry level jobs. The core skills of speaking, listening, reading, writing and numeracy are embedded in aged care topic-based content.

Topics are based on general core units in the Certificate.

Topics covered in this course include:

- Jobs in the aged care sector
- Strategies for communication with elderly clients
- Written communication at work (handover notes, car plans)
- Reading medicine and food labels
- Work, health and safety (understanding safety (understanding safety signs)
