

Interested in working in the community services sector?

This course will prepare you for working in the community services sector and studying the CHC22015 Certificate II in Community Services at Yarraville Community Centre.

The course aims to develop learners' literacy and numeracy capabilities and understanding of community services as a pathway to the Certificate II in Community Services.
