AMEP Volunteer Tutors can come to your home, a local library or another agreed location to help you with your English.

You can also meet with your tutor over Zoom, Whats App, WeChat or other internet services.

- Tutors are trained volunteers who can focus on the skills you need.
- Tutors can meet you during the day, in the evening or on weekends.
- You can have a Tutor if you are working.
- You can request a Tutor who speaks your language.
- You can have a Tutor AND come to class.
