# Skills for Education and Employment (SEE) program

## Summary of Eligibility Criteria for Referring Agencies (RAs) and SEE Providers

### Who is eligible for the SEE program?

Clients are eligible to undertake the SEE program when they meet <u>all</u> the following criteria:

- √ aged between 15 years and Age Pension age
- √ registered as a job seeker, including as a volunteer job seeker¹
- ✓ deemed suitable for training without any barriers that would prevent successful participation
- ✓ either an Australian citizen or permanent resident or have working rights in Australia.

### Who is NOT eligible for the SEE program?

Clients are **not eligible** to undertake the SEE program if they are:

- a full-time student at the time of referral
- participating in the New Enterprise Incentive Scheme (NEIS); the Adult Migrant English Program (AMEP) or any other program advised from time to time
- \* have exited the program and are seeking a referral within three months of their last exit/program completion date, except where a client is transferring to a new provider
- a current holder of a Skilled Migrant Visa
- currently a secondary visa holder of a person who holds a Skilled Migrant Visa (dependent).

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> From 1 July 2021, SEE program eligibility was expanded to include all job seekers, regardless whether they receive an activity tested income support payment, or receive income support at all. Provided other criteria are met, participants can now be Carers, retrenched workers, and other volunteer job seekers with or without an income support payment.
