Digital Essentials Level 1

The program is designed to build on learner's basic computer skills and at the same time improve their employability skills.

The program provides pathways to further study or employment. This program is delivered at a range of locations throughout the City of Maribyrnong.

Digital Essentials Level 2

Targeted at learners who have limited experience with computers and are wanting to develop online and work related computer skills. This course provides pathways to further study and employment opportunities.

Language and Literacy for Jobseekers

Delivered at the Yarraville Community Centre as well as different locations throughout the City of Maribyrnong.

Recharge Program

A 2-day program focusing on literacy, numeracy & digital skills. Suitable for adults with a mild intellectual disability who wish to improve their skills & engage in the community. Includes gardening, cooking & a range of engaging activities.

Tablets & Devices

Focusing on tablets, iPhones and other small portable devices, this class gives people the opportunity to learn about their personal device and how to get the most out of it.

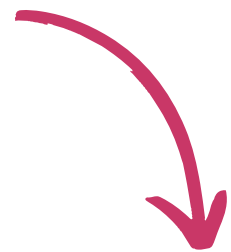

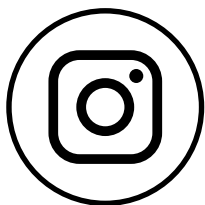
