This course develops initial level English speaking, listening, reading and writing, numeracy and learning skills in highly familiar contexts prior to accessing further English language education and possible employment.

## Where and When:

- Three days per week
- Duration: 20 weeks
- Class times: 9.30am to 3.00pm
- Course starts: February 2026. Rolling intake available until classes reach full capacity.
- Yarraville Community Centre, 9 Victoria Street, Footscray
- Face to face



## Assessment Method:

- Assessment methods include: Questioning (verbal or written), product Based Method (portfolio, listening text/written answers, reading text, spoken text), direct Observation (role play, discussions)

## Pathways:

- Education pathways - Course in initial is considered as pre-beginner level. Further EAL study is most likely required for employment or study pathways requiring more than a very basic level of English. After achieving this qualification candidates may consider:
