# Certificate II in EAL (Access)

This course develops simple English language speaking, listening, reading and writing skills to develop relevant knowledge and skills for simple everyday communications, transactions and community participation.

## Where and When:

- Three days per week
- Duration: 20 weeks
- Class times: 9.30am to 3.00pm
- Course starts: February 2026. Rolling intake available until classes reach full capacity.

## Assessment Method:

- Assessment methods include: Questioning (verbal or written), product Based Method (portfolio, listening text/written answers, reading text, spoken text), direct Observation (role play, discussions)
