This course consolidates the development of straightforward English language speaking, listening, reading and writing skills so that learners can access a range of further study and vocational education options which may require some specialisation.

Where and When:

- Three days per week
- Duration: 20 weeks
- Class times: 9.30am to 3.00pm
- Course starts: February 2026. Rolling intake available until classes reach full capacity.

Assessment Method:

- Assessment methods include: Questioning (verbal or written), product Based Method (portfolio, listening text/written answers, reading text, spoken text), direct Observation (role play, discussions)
