This qualification prepares you for a role where you assist with learning activities, provide general support to students, and help with day-to-day classroom tasks. You'll learn to work responsibly within school policies and procedures, using good judgement to support positive learning experiences.

- Duration: 20 weeks (includes 100 hours of practical placement in a school)
- Class times: 9.30am to 3.00pm

## Assessment Method:
