Language and Literacy for Jobseekers

This program is designed to build the literacy and language skills of learners to pathway in to an accredited language course, volunteering or employment. With a special focus on CALD learners. Delivered at the Yarraville Community Centre as well as different locations throughout the City of Maribyrnong.

Digital Essentials Level 2

Targeted at learners who have limited experience with computers and are wanting to develop online and work related computer skills. The course aims to build on digital literacy skills with a focus on social participating whilst understanding security risks. This course provides pathways to further study and employment opportunities.

Digital Essentials Level 1

The program is designed to build on learner's basic computer skills and at the same time improve their employability skills. The program provides pathways to further study or employment. This program is delivered at a range of locations throughout the City of Maribyrnong.

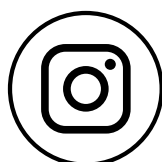
