



# CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability)

Build the skills, confidence and recognised qualification needed to work effectively in the disability sector. This course is designed for support workers who provide person-centred assistance to people living with disability, supporting their independence, choice and inclusion in the community.

## Where and When:

- 3 days per week (Wednesday, Thursday, Friday)
- 26 weeks duration (includes 120 hours of practical placement at an aged care or disability care facility)
- Class times: 9.30am to 3.00pm
- Rolling admissions are available until classes reach full capacity.

- Face to face / Hybrid / Online study options. For hybrid study you must have access to a laptop/desktop, the Microsoft office package and an internet connection.
