Start a rewarding career supporting people with disabilities. This course teaches you how to provide person-centred support in homes and community settings, follow individual support plans, and work safely and confidently. You'll also develop skills that can help you take on team-leading responsibilities in the future.

## Entry Requirements

Completion of CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing and Disability) or CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability) or CHC30408 Certificate III in Disability PLUS the CHCSS00125 Entry to Certificate IV in Disability Support Skill Set.

- 2 days per week (Mondays and Tuesdays)
- Duration: 20 weeks (includes practical placement at a disability services or care facility)
- Class times: 9.30am - 3.00pm
- Rolling admissions are available until classes reach full capacity
